Information for the pageant is enclosed with this letter. There are a few forms that you will need to return to me as soon as possible, as well as a schedule for the day, and information about ad sales for our pageant program, which helps to fund our scholarships. You will need to make sure to sign the correct contract for your division – Miss/Teen. Please try to get ALL forms and ads in as soon as possible.

The Ephraim Bee Festival will be held on July 17, 2021, and the newly chosen royalty will be required to report by 8:00 am to begin the festivities. The Queens will be in attendance for the entire day, and a luncheon on Sunday, July 18th. Other duties include parade and event appearances throughout the year. The pageant team does understand that there will be conflicts, but this position includes the expectation of representation at area events. Some of those might be:

- Doddridge County Homecoming Parade, usually in October
- Salem Apple Butter Festival Parade the first full weekend in October
- West Union's Veteran's Day Parade
- Visiting royalty at other Fairs and Festivals pageants

Remember that you will need a nice interview outfit, fun fashion/sense of style outfit, and evening gown for competition, as well as shoes, jewelry, makeup, and other accessories. It is also a good idea to bring an extension cord and extra mirror, just in case!

Saturday, July 10, 2021 – West Union, WV JUDGING INFORMATION

There are 5 categories for Miss and 4 categories for Teen Contestants that will be judged by a panel of judges to determine the titleholders.

Sense of Style Competition – This category requires a nice outfit that represents the contestant's sense of style. Many contestants choose to wear a cocktail dress. It should fit well, look nice, be tasteful, and eye-catching. This portion is judged on stage during the pageant.

Evening Gown Competition – We strongly suggest a floor length gown that complements you and that you feel comfortable wearing, but anything formal that looks good on you would be fine.

Private Judges Interview – Contestants will be interviewed by the judges prior to the start of the pageant. Contestants should wear a suit or nice dress for the interview.

On-Stage Interview – Contestants will do an interview consisting of a question(s). Evening gowns will be worn for the on-stage interview. Teens only will be provided a list pf questions that will be used on stage from a "fishbowl".

On Stage Promo – <u>Queen Contestants Only</u> will be asked to create a 30 second festival promotion to be read backstage during interview.

Miss Congeniality – This segment does not determine any of the titles. The contestants vote on this award themselves.

Miss Photogenic - This segment does not determine any of the titles. Photos will be judged by an outside panel of judges/photographers for this award.

Crowd Favorite Award - This segment does not determine any of the titles. This award goes to the contestant that receives the most crowd votes (\$1.00 per vote) at the door.

Saturday, July 10, 2021 – West Union, WV Queen & Teen Contestant Contract

- 1. I have never been married, had a marriage annulled, and I am not currently married.
- 2. I have never borne a child, been pregnant, and I am not with child.
- 3. I am a female citizen of West Virginia.
- 4. I am 16-21 years of age (Queen division), 13-16 years of age (teen division) as of 1/1/22. I understand that if I am in the queen division and I turn 22 years of age before 1/1/22, I will not qualify for the WVAF pageant and an alternate will substitute for me as the Ephriam Bee Festival representative.
- 5. I am of good moral character.
- 6. I will demonstrate good sportsmanship, be responsible for my possessions, and respect the belongings of others. Festival and pageant staff will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 7. I understand that there is no camera or cell phone use permitted in the dressing room area. I also understand that only myself and pageant staff are permitted in the backstage/dressing room area.
- 8. I have never been convicted of any crime and do not have any criminal charge pending against me.
- 9. I have never performed any act or engaged in any activity that is or could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, immodest, indecent, or in bad taste.
- 10. I am in reasonably good health and can to the best of my knowledge fully participate in all pageant activities. I have or will notify the pageant director of any major medical conditions.
- 11. If chosen as a queen or teen queen, I hereby contract and agree to participate in events contingent with the Ephraim Bee Festival. I also agree to make appearances at city, county, and state events when
- needed throughout the year, including but not limited to the Ephraim Bee Festival and other local events as necessary. Additionally, the Ephraim Bee Festival has the right to contact you for other appearances and will give you enough notice to be able to attend.
- 12. Each titleholder's reign will be until the date of the Ephraim Bee Festival Pageant in 2022. The Queen Bee is allowed to participate in other pageants, except for other Fairs and Festival titles for the current year. The Teen Bee is allowed to participate in other pageants, including Fairs and Festival titles.
- 13. Scholarship money will be awarded upon the Queen titleholders completing their reign.
- 14. Queen & Teen Bee are to dress appropriately at all festival events. No short shorts or dresses, no midriff tops or tube tops, etc. Please contact me if you have questions about the dress code.
- 15. The Queen and Teen are expected to present themselves, the festival and the chamber in a positive manner when in public and when posting to social media sites. The pageant committee may request inappropriate communications be removed from social media.
- 16. I understand that decisions made by the director and pageant committee are final.
- 17. I understand that while competing at the state WVAF pageant, no male guests are permitted to accompany me in my hotel room with the exception of immediate family.
- 18. Your prize package will be awarded at the festival or at a time given by the director, although since most is donated it might be a few weeks before everything is in depending on the business that has donated some items.

I understand that if selected as a scholarship winner, failure to participate in my festival (Ephraim Bee Festival) or related events, as well as fulfilling any other duties throughout the year including crowning the new queen in 2022, may disqualify me from receiving the scholarship (Queen titleholders). The festival committee (Ephraim Bee Festival) will let you know well in advance of any events that you are needed to represent us at.
